The team, which included Bryan Bramwell, Diane Chafe, Sherry Walsh

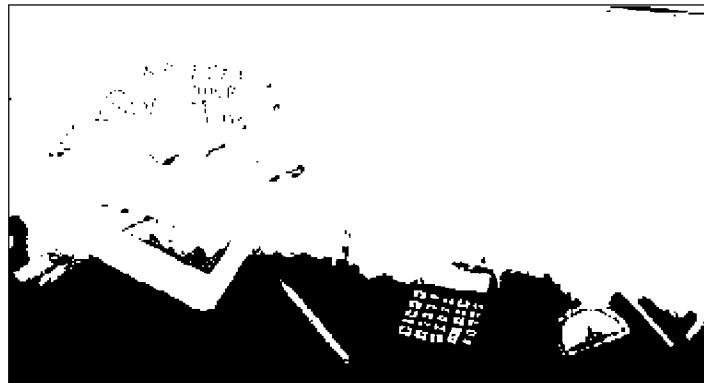
and Osmond, obviously produced a stellar proposal because the school was successful in securing the valuable grant.
